## EMANCIPATION NOTICE

The age of majority is eighteen years of age under the Ohio law (Ohio Revised Code Section 3109.01), The duty of a parent to pay support under a child support order continues beyond the age of 18 if the child continuously attends on a full-time basis any recognized and accredited high school, or a court-issued child support order provides that the duty of support continues beyond the age of eighteen. Except for child support orders that require support to continue after age nineteen, the order shall terminate at nineteen.

Support Enforcement System records indicate that your child, \_\_\_\_\_, became 18 years of age on \_\_\_\_\_. This could result in termination of support for this child unless he or she still attends high school on a full-time basis or your order states that support will continue past the age of nineteen.

If this is the last minor child on this order, the order will terminate. TERMINATION DOES NOT CANCEL THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY'S AUTHORITY TO COLLECT OVER DUE OR UNPAID SUPPORT ON YOUR BEHALF. It does mean that no current support will be owed after termination.
